What Is PAYGO?

PAYGO is a new way of buying electricity from AmerenUE. Instead of buying electricity **after** you use it, you use an AmerenUE PAYGO Card to buy electricity **before** you use it. PAYGO puts YOU in control!

What Can PAYGO Do For Me?

Because you buy your electricity before you use it, you will not receive an electric bill. That means no deposits and no late fees!

By using PAYGO, you can also get rid of your old AmerenUE balance. For every six months that you use PAYGO, AmerenUE will reduce your outstanding balance by 25%. If you are a PAYGO customer for the full two years of the program, your old balance will be gone!

Plus, the PAYGO display box in your home gives you important information about your electricity. It can tell you how fast you are using electricity, how much you used yesterday, and how much you used last month.

The bottom line: With AmerenUE's PAYGO, You Control It!

How Does PAYGO Work?

With PAYGO, you buy electricity ahead of time at a 24-hour AmerenUE PAYGO station. You get your AmerenUE PAYGO Card when you buy your electricity. The PAYGO Card contains your account information and the amount of electricity you have purchased. A display box inside your home keeps track of how much electricity you have used, what the electricity is costing you and how much electricity you have left.

Who Can Use PAYGO?

PAYGO is a special program only for AmerenUE customers living in St. Clair County who are qualified to receive LIHEAP (Low-Income Heating and Energy Assistance Program) funds.
